General Rules

- Blinds will last 20 minutes. Dealers may adjust this time frame to no less than 15 minutes, and should do so only when time constraints demand it.
- If no alternate list exists, breaks should occur after levels 5 and 10 and should last 10 minutes. However, breaks will be at dealer discretion.
- If an alternate list exists, no breaks will occur until the alternate list has been exhausted. Breaks will then be at dealer discretion.
